SOCIETY OBJECTIVES

1. To actively recruit members from Modderfontein and surrounding communities and encourage interest in conservation, with a view to maintaining a suitable balance between its many aspects.
2. To strive for the protection and management of indigenous flora and fauna, including bird species.
3. To encourage and promote interest in preserving the natural and historical aspects of Modderfontein.
4. To act as environmental watchdog within the Modderfontein area.
5. To provide guidance to AECI, Residents Associations and local authorities on policy regarding the purpose, use and development of the Modderfontein Nature Reserve (MNR).
6. To formulate and maintain policy on the removal and replacement of alien plant species in the MNR.
7. To act as advisors on the development of the MNR.
8. To facilitate experiential environmental education and training for school children from a full range of cultural backgrounds.
9. To promote environmental research projects at secondary and tertiary education levels, and post-graduate studies.
10. To co-ordinate and encourage special interest activities in the form of special conservation sub-groups.

MODDERFONTEIN NATURE RESERVE
GENERAL RULES AND CODE OF CONDUCT

This area has been established by AECI to demonstrate the harmonious relationship that can exist between industry and nature, as well as conserving a natural part of the area and our heritage.

Access to the MNR is a privilege and implies a responsibility towards the conservation of its flora, fauna and historical features: the heritage of future generations.

All visitors are required to indemnify AECI and to observe a code of conduct in keeping with the following objectives:

1. The speed limited is 40 km/h unless otherwise indicated.
2. Vehicles are only allowed on designated roads.
3. The public is urged not to enter areas which are clearly marked as no entry areas.
4. No weapons, explosives, poisons, traps, snares or catapults may be brought into the area.
5. Do not tamper with any valves, pumps, pipelines, gates and electrical equipment you may come across.
6. No swimming or fishing in the dams or streams is allowed.
7. NO SMOKING OR LIGHTING OF FIRES IS PERMITTED.
8. No dogs are permitted.
9. No person may be present in the MNR while under the influence of liquor or any other dependence-producing substance.
10. No cameras are permitted.

Please respect:

1. **THE VEGETATION** by keeping to the roads and pathways to avoid tramping and erosion and by not collecting or damaging any plants, flowers or seeds or mutilating trees.
2. **THE WILDLIFE** by not killing, collecting, enticing, disturbing or feeding any wild animals or birds.
3. **THE SURROUNDINGS** by not defacing any tree, rock, building, notice board or road in any manner and by not tampering with or removing any geological or historical or archaeological material and by not throwing any refuse, litter or other harmful objects into streams or on the land, but only into designated containers.
4. **OTHER PEOPLE** by not doing anything or using any appliance in such a manner that it may be a disturbance to any other person or wild animal.

Any person who fails to comply with these rules and regulations shall be guilty of an offence and will be asked to leave the Park and/or be prosecuted.

Visitors must sign that they are familiar with the indemnity statement and comply with all reasonable requests of the officer-in-charge.
